Maria Cristina Aldeguer-Roque and Special Presidential Assistant for Investments and Economic Affairs Sec. Frederick Go. Team Canada was headed by their Minister for Export Promotion, International Trade and Economic Development, the Hon. Mary Ng MP. She was assisted by Canadian Ambassador to the Phils. Hon. David Hartman. The Group first visited Indonesia before checking on the Philippines.
